Pursuant to previous agreement the Board of County Commissioners met in County Clerk's office at 9 A.M. Tuesday Feb. 8, 1910 Present W.L. North C.H. Cleveland, and Geo. McVeigh. Absent none. The reading of proceedings of last meeting were passed for the present.

The County Clerk was authorized to notify undertakers that bids would be received for Burial of Paupers for the year 1910. B.A. Mayo, Joel Field Elmer Fuley, J.C. Stearns J.C. Nove, W.E. McGehee L.J. Black, L.R. Roushawn, Jane Sunday, Mrs. Bettie Weerr, H.H. Firey Noah Gregory Wm Vance, J.H. Smith, Baptist Church Red Fork, J.H. Smith & Texas Co. each filed an Affidavit of Erroneous assessment same was examined and ordered stricken from Tax Rolls.

The following Depository Bonds were approved upon motion of Board and County Treasurer, was instructed to deposit county funds therein. Merchant & Planters Bank & The Oklahoma State Bank, The Bond of A.J. McCarney Justice of the Peace Lynn Lane Township & P.O. Brannon, Clerk of Dawson Township was on motion accepted.

Upon motion of Board in matter of Dist No. 2 the District was formed and an order granted to Surveyor and viewers to make permanent survey.

Bids for Burial of Paupers, for 1910, Depository Bonds of Mer. & Planters & the Oklahoma State Bank were approved. Assessments stricken from rolls. Successor Clerk Dawson Twp. were accepted.

Dist. no. 2 formed. Bonds of P.O. Brannon, Clerk Dawson Twp. were accepted.

Price, Middleton, & Walker appointed viewers Bowles Twp. Canton Bridge Co. lowest bidder. Bids on Bridges opened. Viewers & Co. Surveyor, lay out & view road Bixby Twp.
