purchased new carpet and all the elevators will be re-carpeted over the next two weeks. Rudd will look into the possibility of providing more lighting in the elevators.

Jan Parks and Jim Thomas from Community Service Council discussed the Underage Drinking Report. Park's said the primary intent of the report is to stimulate thinking and increase public awareness about the extent of the problem. Their goal is to generate activities and mobilize the community around the issue that we need to create an environment, both political and social, that does not accept underage drinking. Underage drinking impacts the jail system, teen suicide, teen pregnancy, and child abuse. The following are recommendations from the Tulsa Drug Strategy Coalition:


- Lower county parks' winter curfew hours.
- Provide weekend staff year round at county parks.
- Require server training of individuals serving beer at park festivals and special events.
- Continue to increase the visibility of law enforcement at county parks on weekends and week days from 3:30 to curfew.

Selph agreed with the increased visibility of law enforcement at the county parks and he believes the Sheriff's Office has made a diligent effort to increase visibility.

Thomas discussed the creation of a Youth Commission, which they would like to see become a coordinated effort between the county, city, and school system. Thomas and Parks will come back to the Board in March with a completed plan and would be able to detail what the county's involvement would be.
