The Township Board of Shiatook Township filed a petition for road in section 33-19-12 as per plat on file in County Clerk's office. The same was accepted and the following viewers appointed J. H. Stevens, L. C. Myers, D. C. Monfort, together with County Surveyor to meet on Mch. 4, 1910 to lay out and view said road. In the Matter of Road petition of Woolly Jackman, & Badger for road in Dawson Twp. the Board upon motion reconsidered action and allowed property owners affected \$125.00 per acre for land condemned.

The County Clerk was authorized to pay teachers in school Dist. No. 37 & 47 and \$500.00 was appropriated to pay teachers in said Districts.

On motion of Board the County Clerk was authorized to advertise for bids on property formerly occupied by colored school containing two lots and house located near present building upon the following terms: One half cash down one fourth in 6 months and one fourth in 12 months, deferred payments to bear 8% interest or purchaser may pay at his option cash. Deed to be placed in escrow until final payment is made. Certified check made payable to County Clerk of 10% of amount accompanying all bids. We reserve the right to reject any or all bids.
