That parcel of ground that lies between Blocks 2 and 3, in Lynn Lane Estates Addition, being a subdivision of a part of the NEg of Section 11, Township 19 North, Range 14 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof,

said road to be vacated, being a strip of land approximately 70 feet wide, and approximately 850 feet long, and running diagonally in a Northwesterly and Southeasterly direction, and situated in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 11, the Northerly terminal thereof being located on East Eleventh Street, and the Southerly terminal thereof being located on the East Section line of said Section 11.

And said Board of County Commissioners being fully advised in the premises, finds: That the allegations of said petition are true; that said petition is signed by more than twelve free holders residing in the vicinity of said road, and is in all respects sufficient; That said J. R. Foresman, one of the petitioners, has filed his bond herein, conditioned as required by law; that due and legal notice of this hearing has been given to the public, for more than twenty days by advertisement in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official County Paper of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and that more than six days notice in writing has been caused to be given by J. R. Foresman, one of the petitioners, to Gladys H. Foresman, J. R. Foresman, Ray C. Holloway, Lynn Lane School District No. 1. Joe Croney, Pauline Croney, Jack Brown, Mary Brown, Roger Williams, Dovey Williams, and Joe Schumann, Lynn Lane School District No. 1., being served by personal service upon J. J. Sheets, D. Blankenship, and J. R. McChesney, said persons being all of the members of the Board of Trustees of said School District, said persons so personally notified by all of the owners through whose land said road goes, a copy of which said notice together with proof of publication and proof of service thereof have been duly filed herein, with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma; that said land upon which said road is located, is outside of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and is no part of any plat or addition to the City of Tulsa; that said road has never been used by the public as a road or highway; that the same is unnecessary and impractical for the reason that said locality is already adequately served by East Eleventh Street and said East Section line of said Section 11, and that if said street or road be retained as a part of the highway system of Tulsa County, it would be necessary to construct a bridge and an expensive approach thereto on the Southerly portion thereof by reason of a creek and draw, which crosses the same to the Southerly portion of said Blocks 2 and 3; and by reason of all thereof, said road or street together with the dedication thereof, should be vacated, set aside and for naught held, and the road perpetually closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that said petition be, and the same is hereby granted, and that said road and the dedication thereof be, and the same are hereby vacated and set aside and said road be, and the same is hereby perpetually closed.
