J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Mrs. Pearl Lawson, Telephone Operator, be and the same is hereby accepted as at the close of business July 14th, 1943.
