R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the County Attorney in Case No. 14, 420 Criminal, in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the 8th day of February, 1951, forfeited the appearance bond of defendant Ulysses Keys and Lonnie A. Oates and John T. Gilliland, sureties; and

WHEREAS, suit was instituted in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for recovery on said bond in the amount of \$1,000.00, being case No. 81,978; and

WHEREAS, the sureties on said bond have offered to compromise and settle said matter for the sum of \$500.00, plus \$8.05 accrued court costs, and the County Attorney has recommended said settlement;
