Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Charles C. Disbrow, Supervisor, Tax Section, Home Owner's Loan Corporation for the year 1948, and approved by Hugh Webster, Assistant County Attorney, be and the same is hereby approved. This covers real estated located in Section 32, Township 20, Range 13 East.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the County Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate with the owners of land west of Frisco Railroad and skirting Red Fork Hill, referred to in a petition filed with the Board, and ascertain whether it is feasible to purchase a strip of land for road purposes as requested in said petition, the County Engineer to report his recommendations in the matter.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the letter dated March 19, 1949, from Ralsa F. Morley, requesting the Board to start condemnation proceedings against the owners of property located in Section 16, Township 19, North, Range 13 East, in order to assist him in securing the right-of-way for an outlet or ingress to his property, be and the same is hereby referred to the County Engineer.
