

Friday November 1st 1918.

A joint meeting of the County Commissioners of Tulsa and Rogers County was held in the offices of the County Commissioners on Friday November 1st, 1918, at 2 o'clock, P.M., for the purpose of a final settlement of the territory voted from Rogers County to Tulsa County. Present C.D.Evans, I.W.Slack, S.E.Wood, W.J.Eldredge Clerk, R.A. Martin, W.L.North, C.E.Suppes, and Lewis Cline Clerk.

The first business was that of electing a chairman. A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by I.W.Slack that C.D.Evans act as chairman of the meeting. Motion prevailed. A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by I.W.Slack that Lewis Cline act as Secretary of the meeting.

A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by I.W.Slack that we accept the valuation of Collinsville Township as made by the County Assessor of Rogers County for the year 1918, for the purpose of settlement.

A motion was made by C.E.Wood and seconded by I.W.Slack that the same basis of settlement be observed in the County as agreed upon in the township according to the assessed valuation of 1918. Motion prevailed, all members voting "aye".


A motion was made by R.A.Martin and seconded by I.W.Slack that Rogers County collect all taxes including the 1918 taxes and back taxes up to June 30th 1919, and that Rogers County Treasurer remit to Tulsa County its proportion of the 1918 taxes as same is collected and that on or before this date Rogers County furnish Tulsa County with a delinquent tax roll on the property involved for all previous years. All members voted "aye".

A motion was made by W.L.North and seconded by I.W.Slack that the two County Clerks, W.J.Eldredge and Lewis Cline, prepare the valuations for the next meeting of the Board to be held on Monday November 18th for the final settlement.

A motion was made by W.L.North that the Board adjourn to meet again on Monday November 18th 1918, in Tulsa, at the office of the County Commissioners in the Court House. Meeting adjourned to meet Monday November 18th 1918 at 2 o'clock P.M.
