EMERGENCY REPAIR WORK.

Letting August 30th. 1926.

Honorable County Commissioners
Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Gentlemen:

The undersigned, having examined the location and character of the work proposed to be done in connection with protecting the piers and lifting vertically and shifting to correct alignment and grade the Bridge seat on the Second Two Tubes west of the east end of the Jenks-Arkansas River Bridge, proposes to furnish all labor, tools and equipment, materials, etc., and to assume all risk, liability, etc., and to safeguard the public in the continuous use of the said Bridge insofar as practicable, performing the work within 40 days from this date, as follows:

For driving sheet piling around tubes; excavating all materials from around Tubes to provide footing as perscribed by County Engineer; and for the driving of all piling, construction of framework and each and every detail necessary, including all labor, materials and equipment and to lift vertically and horizontally to the correct alignment and grade the ends of both spans resting upon the said tubes, concreting and setting the same in their correct alignment and grade, for lump sum of
Forty Five Hundred Dollars \$4,500.00

And, in addition 15.0 C Y @ \$20.00 per C Y 300.00

And, for reinforcing steel that may be placed in the footings by direction of the County Engineer.
