R E S O L U T I O N .

BE IT RESOLVED: By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on this the 18th. day of February, 1924, that there should be created a drainage district in Bixby Township; that drainage ditches, levees, etc. should be constructed for the purpose of draining and protecting lands adjacent to Bixby, Oklahoma, on the North, West, South and East of said Town of Bixby.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That by reason of the making of such improvement it is believed by this Board that great benefits would accrue to the public, and to the public highway system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That it should be recommended to the land owners in the area suggested for such improvement, that they take steps as is provided by law to initiate a petition, asking for the creation of a drainage district.

AND, IN CONSIDERATION of the benefits that would accrue to the public and
