RESOLUTION

Be it remembered that at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held at the Courthouse in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 8th day of September, 1936, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by said Board of County Commissioners, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma, has agreed to submit to the Secretary of Agriculture, a project for the improvement of 0.313 miles of Secondary Highway from a point on the Section Line between Sections 13 and 14, T 20 N, R 13 E, 303 feet South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between said Sections to a point on said Section Line, 1354 feet North of said $\frac{1}{4}$ corner with funds apportioned to the State under Section 204 of the National Industrial Recovery Act, and

WHEREAS, the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, desires that such improvement be made and does agree to maintain said highway in a manner satisfactory to the State Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma after its improvement, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and execute a contract and agreement with said State Highway Commission carrying out the purposes of this resolution.
