MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21st, 1936.

The Board of Jounty Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, September 21st, 1936, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by Mary M. Kirkland, President of Albert E. Kirkland, Inc., covering personal property for the year 1935, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

Mr. John H. Miller, Chairman, deposited with the County Treasurer on September 11th, 1936 \$108.50 collected from the operation of the municipal hospital. Receipt No. 16435. Same was ordered filed.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by E. A. Watterfield, Court Clerk, for the month of August, 1936, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gray, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Hopkins. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.
