

THURSDAY, APRIL 14, 1949

Pursuant to a recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. with all members present: Claude W. Bailey, Chairman; John Couch, Member; Roy Evans, Member; Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Claude W. Bailey, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted:

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of April, 1949, the Highway Commission of the State of Oklahoma proposed awarding a contract, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, and the Public Roads Administration for the construction of Oklahoma Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S-318 (4), said project to be constructed under plans and specifications approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa, on the 14th day of April, 1949, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the lowest responsible bid at a letting held in the Capitol Office Building at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on the 5th day of April, 1949, on said project in the estimated amount of \$57,559.41, was submitted by: Layman & Sons.

BE IT RESOLVED; That the Board of County Commissioners concur in the proposed award of a contract for the construction of Oklahoma Federal Aid Secondary Project No. S-318 (4) to said low bidder: Layman & Sons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; That the Department of Highways of the State of Oklahoma is hereby authorized to expend as much of the Farm-to-Market funds derived from HB 470 of the Twentieth Legislature and HB 253 of the Twenty-first Legislature and allocated to Tulsa County as are necessary to obtain Federal participation and to process and construct said project in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates furnished by Tulsa County.

Adopted this 14th day of April 1949, by the unanimous vote of said Board of County Commissioners.
