Van Zandt, Justice Of The Peace, Deceased, be accepted, filed, and referred to the County Attorney's office. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County owns a 1947 Mercury Four Door Sedan Motor No. 799A 2040972 and,

WHEREAS, Said Mercury Sedan being not generally serviceable for the uses and purposes of the Highway Department, which said Mercury Sedan belongs and was purchased and paid for from County Highway Funds, and

WHEREAS, The Highway Department is in need of an automobile and has found that a trade or exchange can be made with the Fred Jones Ford Company of Tulsa for a new 1951 Four Door Ford Sedan Motor No. BIMP 120660 in exchange for said Mercury Sedan and a further consideration of payment by Tulsa County to the Fred Jones Company, the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Forty Two Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$1,242.60).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to transfer title to the aforesaid Mercury Sedan and deliver same to the Fred Jones Company in exchange for said Ford Four Door Sedan when accompanied by proper transfer of title to Tulsa County, and that the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to the Fred Jones Company in the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Forty Two Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$1,242.00) Payable from Account No. 6B designated as Highway Equipment of the Tulsa County Highway Department CASH FUND
