There having been filed with the County Clerk a bond in the sum of \$2,000.00

Signed by 5 residents and owners of Park View Drainage District No. 2, with fourteen good and sufficient sureties, the conditions of such being that upon its approval and acceptance by the Board of County Commissioners, of Tulsa County, said state, and upon its being filed with the County Clerk of said County, if the drainage ditch proposed to be constructed in said district be constructed, the obligations thereof shall be void, but if said ditch be not constructed such obligation shall be in full force and effect for the payment of all expenses of viewers, surveyors, notices and all costs and expenses incurred in connection with said proposed ditch, all as heretofore required by said Board upon Motion of Commissioner F. M. Wooden seconded by Commissioner Ira Short, adopted by all members voting "AYE", said bond was approved and accepted by said Board of County Commissioners, and ordered filed with the County Clerk.

The Judge of the District Court of Tulsa, having certified to this Board that he has appointed viewers in Park View Drainage District No. 2 of said county, and the names of such viewers, an order was presented which was read by the Clerk, and upon motion of Commissioner F. M. Wooden seconded by Commissioner Short adopted by all members voting in the affirmative. Said order was the signed by the Chairman and attested by the Clerk, and ordered approved and filed.
