C O M P L A I N T.

IN RE: MORNINGSIDE HOSPITAL.

Comes now the above named claimant and presents the following claim to the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Your Complainant alleges that all of its property, both real and personal, is non-taxable and not subject to taxation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma. That the purpose for which the property of this claimant is used and the use to which said property is put, is such as to make it exempt from taxation. That the property of your Claimant has been placed upon the tax rolls of this County for the years of 1928, 1929 and 1930 and that the same is non-taxable for the years herein stated or any other years.

WHEREFORE, Your Complainant prays that this Honorable Board declare all of the property of complainant non-taxable and not subject to taxation for the years hereinabove noted and for any other years and that a certificate of error be issued by this Honorable Board to this complainant, striking from the tax rolls of Tulsa County, the property of this complainant and ordering that said property is not subject to taxation.

ORDER AND JUDGMENT

NOW, On this 6th. day of July, 1931, the above matter coming on to be heard before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, upon the complaint of the above named Claimant, and it appearing by the testimony of the claimant and at least one reputable witness borne out by the records of the county, that all of the property of the above named claimant, both real and personal, is and was exempt from taxation and is and was non-taxable for the years 1928, 1929, 1930 and any other years; and it appearing that the purpose for which the property, both real and personal of said claimant, is and was used and the use to which said property is and was put is such as to make it exempt from taxation and the Board of County Commissioners being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS, THEREFORE, Ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the regular meeting of said Board that the property, both real and personal of the said claimant, the Morningside Hospital and Training School for Nurses be and the same is hereby ordered to be non-taxable and not subject to taxation for the years 1928, 1929, 1930 and any other years, and that the same be and it is hereby stricken from the tax rolls of Tulsa County.

AND, it is further ordered and decreed that a certificate of error be issued to the complainant above named showing that the complaint has been investigated by the said Board and that the said Board has been satisfied of the truth of the allegations of said complaint and directing the same to the County Treasurer of Tulsa County as provided by law.
