Comes now the above named claimant and presents the following claim to the Honorable

ORDER AND JUDGMENT

NOW, On this 6th. day of July, 1931, the above matter coming on to be heard before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, upon the complaint of the above named Claimant, and it appearing by the testimony of the claimant and at least one reputable witness borne out by the records of the county, that all of the property of the above named claimant, both real and personal, is and was exempt from taxation and is and was non-taxable for the years 1928,1929,1930 and any other years; and it appearing that the purpose for which the property, both real and personal of said claimant, is and was used and the use to which said property is and was put is such as to make it exempt from taxation and the Board of County Commissioners being fully advised in the premises.
