A motion was made by Ira Short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the resignation of D. N. Speake as constable within and for district No. 9, Jenks, be and the same is hereby accepted this the 20th day of December, 1921. Motion prevailed.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ira Short that the Bond of Elmer Mercer be approved. All members voting in the affirmative the motion was by the chairman declared carried.

It is moved by Ira Short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the resignation of T. N. Griffith, Justice of the Peace of District No. 11, Sand Springs, Oklahoma, and filed on this day be and the same is hereby accepted, effective December 21st, 1921, and that the said T. N. Griffith be and he is hereby ordered as by law provided, there being no successor appointed to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation at this time, to turn to Art Stanton, Justice of the Peace within and for the said District No. 11, all dockets, files, papers, statutes, session laws, and all things belonging to the said office, and now in the possession of the said T. N. Griffith, Justice of the Peace. And it is further ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby directed to serve on the said T. N. Griffith a certified copy of this motion.
