FRIDAY, JUNE 22, 1945

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at at the hour of 10:00 O'clock A. M., with following members present: Curtis Greer, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Robert L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Curtis Greer, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund in the amount of \$3,581.29, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$8,170.93, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, to approve the new brand for cattle and horses HAJ (joined as shown in Register) registered by H. A. Jenkins. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the Summarized Financial Report of Water District No. 3 of Turley, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, from March 19, 1945 to June 19, 1945, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Percy Bell, Grader Operator County Highway Department, District No. 2, be dropped from the County payroll as of July 1, 1945. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until 1:30 P. M. Motion carried.
