Upon the instruction of the Chairman, the following sealed bids were opened:

Bids of the Standard Paving Company on the following projects: Nos. 2-C Extension to Shell Creek Bridge, length 0.2102 Miles in the amount of \$4,112.60; 2-E Surfacing approaches over Levee West of Jenks, in the amount of \$2,153.10; 2-M, length 0.1837, in the amount of \$3,657.30, together with their bid check in the amount of \$500.00, and the bids of the Amulco Products, Inc. on 2-C Extension, Shell Creek Bridge, length 0.2102 miles; amounting to \$4,401.10; 2-E approaches over Levee West of Jenks, length 0.1096 miles in the amount of \$2,321.70 and 2-M, approaches over Levee, south of Jenks, length 0.1837 miles, amounting to \$3,920.80, together with their bid check for \$550.00. Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Evans, that these bids be referred to the County Engineer for his recommendation and report. Motion unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the following Resolution on the Bixby-Snake Creek Drainage projects, be and the same is hereby approved:

RESOLUTION

The County Commissioner believe that local interests would, for any levee or other local flood-protection project at Bixby (a) provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements, and rights-of-way neccessary for the construction of the project; (b) hold and save the United States free from damages due to the construction works; (c) maintain and operate all the works after completion; and (d) make any alterations to existing improvements, other than railroads, occasioned by the construction works.
