AUTHORITY TO RELEASE SECURITIES

We, the undersigned Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, being in legal meeting convened, have given due consideration to the demand of the Fourth National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, an authorized depository of said County, and the verification of the accounts of said County with said depository Bank as made by the County Treasurer herein, and find such withdrawal will leave the accounts of the County adequately secured within the sum of \$800,000.00; and therefore we do hereby direct and command that the specific securities identified by the within and foregoing detailed list in the aggregate sum of \$200,000.00 be released by the County Treasurer and the Custodian of said securities to the Owner Bank herein or on his order, immediately and without delay.
