* The following Bonds were approved W. L. Best, Treas. of Red Fork Township, John Hall Clerk of Wekiwa Township & Union Trust Company. On motion of Board The Union Trust Company was made a County Depository and the County Treas' was instructed to put funds therein.

On motion of Board County Treasurer was instructed to distribute all monies collected from the Railroads to the different funds. On motion of Board the County Treas. was authorized to place the fund in 322 to the supply fund.

On motion of Board the County Fund derived from the territory recently added from Wagoner County was ordered placed in the contingent fund.

The Board of The Exchange National Bank was approved and the county treasurer, was authorized to place the county funds therein;

On motion of Board the county clerk was instructed to advertise for sealed proposals, for site for poor farm, said land to contain not less than 20 nor more than 160 acres said land to be not more than three miles from Railroad station Part of said land to be fertile with stone on part suitable for Quarry Immediate possession must be given, Certified check of 10 % to accompany all proposals;
