WHEREAS, since the institution of the above suit, the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma in the case of Town of Buffalo vs Walker, et al, and reported in 257 Pac.Rep. Page 766, has held that the bonds involved in the above first described suit were in doubt, and

WHEREAS, it appearing that the exchange of the original bonds issued by the said Wayne L Dickey for the present bonds now held by Tulsa County would not, in view of the decision of the Supreme Court, make said former Treasurer and his Surety liable in this action.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Attorney be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter a dismissal in said Case numbered 34793, and styled as above and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Attorney is hereby instructed to bring proper action against the Town of Buffalo, Harper County, Oklahoma,, to enforce the payment on past due interest coupons on bonds now held by the County Treasurer and issued by said Municipality.
