That any and all bidders at the sale of bonds of Tulsa County in the sum of \$560,000.00, held in the Tulsa County Court House in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 22nd day of December, 1941, may, at his or its option, qualify such bid with the words that said bidder may at his or its option withdraw said bid only in event that the bonds above described are made taxable in any manner by the Act of Congress of the United States, approved by the President of the United States, prior to the date of delivery of said bonds by Tulsa County to the successful bidder;

That the bidder who desires to possess such right to qualify his or its bid, as set out above, shall evidence his acceptance of such right in writing according to the terms and conditions set forth above.
