

Twenty Three (23) all in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East; and along and over Factory & Frisco Avenues in West Tulsa and additions thereto, and the rights hereby granted shall be and remain in full force and effect as long as said highways, roads and Avenues shall be used by the said West Belt Railway, or its assigns, for railroad purposes.

This franchise and right is granted to said Railway Company by this Board in consideration of the benefits industrially and commercially, resulting to said Tulsa County, and is granted upon the express condition that the said Railway Company shall construct and maintain all crossings of highways and roads covered herein, so as not to interfere with public traffic thereon, and also in accordance with the rules and regulations of this Board and subject to its approval.

It is also expressly provided, that in the event that such high-way crossings and Avenues should cease to be used for Railway purposes, or the use thereof abandoned by said Railway Company or its assigns, then and in that event the said Railway Company or its assigns, is to restore said highways and avenues, if possible, in the same, or as good a condition, as the same were before their occupation and use by said Company.

Be it further resolved that the operation of this resolution shall be concurrent with the resolution hereto for approval and hereby amended.
