"A BILL;

Authorizing the construction of a Bridge across the Arkansas River at or near Tulsa, Oklahoma."

Bill to
be intro-
duced

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

That the County of Tulsa in the State of Oklahoma, be, and is hereby, authorized to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Arkansas River at a point suitable to the interests of navigation, at or near Tulsa, Oklahoma, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled " An act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March twenty-third, nineteen hundred and six.

Sec. 2. That the right to alter. amend, or repeal this Act is hereby expressly reserved.

There being no further business to transact, a motion was made by Ed Baker and seconded by A. W. Lucas, that the Board adjourn to meet again on Tuesday, December 7th., 1915 at 9 o'clock A.M. Motion carried.
