## RESOLUTION

FOR CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS AGAINST A PART OF LOT 5, IN SECTION 13-TOWNSHIP 19 N, RANGE 11 E. TULSA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Tulsa County is constructing a highway thru and across Sections 13-14, Township 19 N, Range 11 E, and across Section 15-Township 19N, Range 12E,

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary for the public convenience that said highway be constructed so that the traveling public living in the vicinity of Red Fork and West Tulsa may have access to U.S. Highway 64 at the least possible inconvenience,

AND WHEREAS, it has been impossible to agree with the cwners of the land along said proposed highway for the purchase of the right-of-way for said public highway, it is necessary to condemn the following strip of land for highway purposes:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, (klahoma, that the County Attorney be instructed to institute condemnation proceedings for the purpose of condemning the following strip of land as a right-of-way for said highway purpose, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 446.3 feet West of the Southeast corner of lot 5, Section 13-Township 19 N, Range 11 E, thence North 53°51' East a distance of 295.5 feet to a point of curve to the right, radius 2814.9 feet a distance of 250 feet more or less to the East line of said Lot 5; thence North along the East line of Lot 5 a distance of 113.2 feet to the South right-of-way line of the St.Louis and Sand Francisco RR; thence along said right-of-way line on a curve to the left, radius 2914 feet, a distance of 306.9 feet; thence South 53°51' West a distance of 432.5 feet more or less to the South Line of said Lot 5, thence East along the South line of Lot 5, a distance of 169.4 feet to the point of beginning - containing 1.5 acress more or less.

Moved the adoption of the above resolution by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, all voting in the affirmative, the resolution was declared adopted.
