

December 31st, 1941.

The proceeds derived from the sale of said bonds shall be placed in a special fund and used solely for the purpose of building and constructing Tulsa county roads and highways, including the necessary grading, drainage and paving, as set out in the resolution adopted October 30, 1941, and in the proclamation issued on the 30th day of October, 1941, authorizing the calling and holding of such election.

Section 4. That beginning with the year 1942, a continuing annual tax, sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds when due and for the purpose of providing a sinking fund with which to pay the principal of said bonds when due, shall be and is hereby ordered levied upon all the taxable property of said county, in addition to all other taxes, said sinking fund to be designated "The County Road Bonds of 1942 Sinking Fund". Said tax shall be and is hereby ordered certified, levied and extended upon the tax rolls and collected by the same officers, in the same manner and at the same time as the taxes for general purposes in each of said years are certified, levied, extended and collected; that all funds derived from said tax shall be placed in said sinking fund which, together with all interest collected on same, shall be irrevocably pledged to the payment of the interest on and principal of said bonds when and as the same feel due.
