WHEREAS, the County Excise Board of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, has made full compliance with the Legislature mandate set forth in Chapter 40, Session Laws of 1933, by making appropriation and levy for the fiscal year 1936-37, for the purpose of audit and examination of the books and records of the public officers of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the terms of said act, and

WHEREAS, the said Chapter 40, Session Laws of 1933 carried a like mandate to the State Examiner and Inspector of the State of Oklahoma to make such sudit and examination, according to the terms thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners are desirous that the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma be complied with, and are anxious and willing to co-operate with co-ordinate State and County agencies in fulfillment of and compliance with the Constitution and the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE STATE EXAMINER AND INSPECTOR be requested to begin said audit and examination in compliance with the Legislature mandate comprised in said Chapter 40, Session Laws of 1933, under the appropriations made and provided by the Excise Board of Tulsa County for that purpose, and proceed to designate one head Deputy State Examiner and Inspector and such assistant deputies under the Statutes and according to the terms of the Statutes as will permit said audit and examination to be begun and progressed with all facility and dispatch, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the custodian of the building be, and he is hereby directed to arrange working Quarters and facilities for said deputy State Examiners and Inspectors for the progress of the work of said examination, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the officers of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and they are hereby directed to comply with Section 3730, O.S. 1931, by providing said deputy State Examiners and Inspectors access to their records for the purpose of said examination, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as the governing body of Tulsa County, this Board of County Commissioners, be furnished with a typewritten report of the findings of said State Examiner and Inspector after said audit and examination, said report to be supported by exhibits and schedules disclosing the financial condition of each officer's accounts examined and an accounting for his conduct and management of the public funds coming into his hands.
