O R D E R.

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to James Harrington of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Twelve & 21/100 dollars (\$12.21) the following described Lots;

Lots 8 & 9 Block 20, Lots 35-36-37-38 Block 21, Lots 21-22-44 Block 30 All in North Taneha, Subdivision.

AND WHEREAS, the sale of said lots by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the compiled statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at the re-sale, and
