It was moved by Commissioner Gray, that the Chairman of the Board notify by letter, under registered mail, all drug stores, undertakers, hospitals and physicians heretofore handling charity work for the County, that the funds appropriated for charitable purposes for the fiscal year 1933-34 have been exhausted and that no further funds are available for the payment of bills for such charitable work, and that any such work done from Feb. 1st, until the end of the fiscal year June 30th, 1934, will necessarily be done at the risk of those doing same; that the Board of County Commissioners and the members of the board individually assume no responsibility for the payment of such bills, and that they are unable to say whether same will ever be paid.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Bridges, and upon roll call was unanimously carried.

The following letter was directed to all drug stores, undertakers, hospitals and physicians doing business with the County.

Gentlemen:

You are hereby notified that the funds appropriated for the County of Tulsa for charitable purposes for the fiscal year 1933-34 have been exhausted. At the present time there are no funds available for the payment of bills for drugs, ambulance services, undertakers' services, hospitalization and physicians' services to charity patients from February 1st to June 30th, 1934, the end of the fiscal year. The Board of County Commissioners is unable to say whether any plan can be worked out by which such bills can be paid.

Much as we regret it, we are compelled to advise you that the Board of County Commissioners, and the members of the Board individually assume no responsibility for the payment of such bills from Feb. 1st to June 30th, 1934, and if such service is rendered or supplies sold for the use of charity patients, or for hospitalization or physician services, will necessarily be rendered at the risk of those furnishing same, and on an open account, and at their own risk of being able in any way to collect same.
