



MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE
THURSDAY, AUGUST 13, 1987

The Board of County Commissioners met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Melvin C. Rice, Chairman; Lewis Harris, John Selph, Members. Members absent: none. Others present: Clayton Edwards; Ray Jordan; Jack Helton; Frank Thurman; Bill Baker; Wayne Carr; Joan Hastings; Susan Morgan; Janice Lintelman; Mike Kimbrell; Jim Crawley; Terry Tallent.

Sheriff Thurman was present to discuss his storage problems and to request the Board of County Commissioners permit him to build a storage building at the Social Services complex. The Sheriff explained his storage needs are divided into four classifications -- food, records, arrest records, and evidence. He proposes to build a building 50 feet by 100 feet (approximately 8,500 square feet), if the Board will allow him to use the property and have the Highway Department do the dirt work necessary for construction. The building would be divided into three sections with one section temperature controlled.

Harris requested the Sheriff and Ray Jordan look into other possible locations and to study the flooding problem in the proposed location at the Social Services complex.
