

TUESDAY, MAY 17, 1949

Pursuant to a recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. today, with the following members present: Claude W. Bailey, Chairman; John Couch, Member; Andy Stokes, County Clerk, Roy Evans, Member, absent.

Claude W. Bailey, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

The matter of the Petition for the Incorporation of the proposed town of Kanhalwe, Oklahoma, came up for hearing. Mr. J. M. Bush, Attorney, representing the petitioners, requested a continuation on the hearing until Tuesday, May 24, 1949, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. Mr. Robert Davidson, Attorney for the City of Tulsa, appeared in behalf of the City and agreed to the continuation. Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the hearing be continued until Tuesday, May 24, 1949, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M. Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that upon the recommendation of R. L. Dunkle, County Treasurer, the Brookside State Bank, located at 3237 South Peoria Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma, be designated as one of the Depository Banks of Tulsa County.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the request of the County Treasurer for authority for the withdrawal of Securities, County Depositories, in the amount of \$20,000.00 from The National Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, be and the same is hereby approved.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the report filed by Water Improvement District No. 10 of the Cash Receipts and Disbursements from April 1, 1948 to March 31, 1949, be and the same is hereby accepted and ordered filed.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the following claims be and the same are hereby approved for payment, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to issue warrants covering same:
