Motion made by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the Supplemental Appropriation Request for the County General Fund in the total amount of \$65,970.70 be approved, and that the County Clerk be directed to advertise same in compliance with the law. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the resignation of Mrs. Ethel Kinney, Deputy in the County Court Division, effective as of May 14, 1951, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, be approved. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the appointment of James Ray Reidy, as a deputy in the County Court Division, effective as of May 17, 1951, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, be approved. And that the appointment of Jerry M. Melone, as a deputy in the District Court Division, effective as of May 17, 1951, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, be approved. Upon roll call, motion carried.




