WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth does by these presents demise, lease and let unto the second party the ground located in the center of the county highway at the Southwest Corner of Sec. 7, Twp. 17, Range 13, Glen Pool Township, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, now known as Hilltop Service Station, for the purpose of running a filling station.

To have and to hold the same to the second party from the 21st day of October, 1936, to the 21st day of October, 1937. And said second party, in consideration of the premises herein set forth agrees to pay to the first party, as rental for the above described ground the sum of \$35.00 per year, in advance.
