Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that a recess be taken until the hour of 1:00 P.M. Motion carried.

Roy Evans, Chairman presiding the following business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that the salaries of the two permanent P.B.X. Operators of the Tulsa County Court House, Rose Thorpe and Bernice Ward, be increased \$15.00 per month, from \$158.00 to \$173.00, effective July 7, 1947. Motion unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the salaries of the three nurses of the Tulsa County Medical Clinic, listed below, be and the same are hereby increased to the amounts shown opposite their names, as of July 7, 1947. Motion was unanimously carried:

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Tulsa County Financial Statement for the fiscal year 1946-1947, together with the estimate of needs for the fiscal year 1947-1948, be approved in the total amount of \$1,238,784.38, and that the County Clerk be ordered to make publication and submit the said budget to the Tulsa County Excise Board. Motion unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that the Financial Statement for the fiscal year of 1946-1947 and the Estimate of Needs for 1947-1948, in the amount of \$25,650.00, by the Tulsa County Dependent Separate Schools be approved and referred to the County Excise Board.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that a recess be taken until Monday, July 14, 1947, at the hour of 10:00 O'clock A.M. Motion carried.
