OHE VALUOU The Board of County Commissioners in regular session upon this 25th day of January, 1922, having before them the affidavit filed on January 4th, 1922, by H.L.Gogle, C.A. Hanover, Jim Sanders and D.W.Gillis pursuant to section offe of Chapter 42 of the Session laws of Oklahoma (in 1919, asking that said Board of County Commissioners open a road in Section 19, Township 19, Range 13 in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, sixteen and one half feet wide and eighty rods long on the north end of I.W.Oliver's land in said section and said Board of County Commissioners having considered said affidavit, and investigated the matters therein contained, concludes and decides that said road is necessary in order to give the aforesaid citizens, and other citizens in the center of said section an outlet to the county road known as the Henks road.

It is therefore now donsidered, ordered and voted by said Board of County Commissioners that there is a necessity for said road, and that the same should be opened, and it is further ordered that the above named citizens and such other cirizens affected and interested in the opening of said boad are authorized and directed to institute condemnation proceedings as provided by law for the purpose of condemning the aforesaid strip of land for a road; that the land to be condemned is the passway now being used as a private right of way by aforesaid citizens on the north end of the said I.W, Olivers land in said section; that it is sixteen and one half feet wide and runs east eighty rods from the section line and county road known as the Jenks Road.
