In the matter of Equalization of Taxed <sup>law</sup> of Okla Oil Co. of E<sup>1/4</sup> NW<sup>1/4</sup> - 15-17-12, b/fixed at 20<sup>00</sup> per acre as S<sup>1/4</sup> NW<sup>1/4</sup> 15-17-12 & N<sup>1/4</sup> NW<sup>1/4</sup> 22-17-12 b/reduced to 15<sup>00</sup> per acre. In the matter of L.Y. Arnold W<sup>1/4</sup> NE<sup>1/4</sup> 22-17-12, b/reduced to 60<sup>00</sup> per acre.

On motion of Board all oil in steel storage was fixed at 18<sup>00</sup> per bbl.

In the matter of Leon Pratt N<sup>1/4</sup> NW<sup>1/4</sup> of lot 5 sec 32-18-12, for rebate on valuation of property for year 1910 taken for Right of Way by Railroad the same was reduced 100<sup>00</sup>. The above changes were made on appeal from Township Boards.

In the matter of Equalization of Oil by Township the following changes were made:

Mules allowed 10%.

Cattle raised 25%.

Carriages .. 25%.

Swine .. 5%.

Land .. 10%.

W.L. North was authorized to take county Bonds to Guthrie to have them executed.
