Tuesday, January 31st, 1922.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the hour of ten (10) o'clock A. M., January 31st, 1922, with F. M. Wooden and Ira Short, members of the Board and O. D. Lawson Clerk, present, Absent Geo. E. Gilmore.

Motion was made by F. M. Wooden that Ira Short act as temporary chairman.

Motion carried by acclamation.

At an adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County held on the 31st day of January, 1922, in the office of the commissioners in the Court House of said county, the following resolution was introduced by Commissioner F. M. Wooden, who moved its adoption, which was duly seconded by Commissioner Ira Short and the chairman ordered the resolution read.

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the time for the payment of the first half of the 1921 taxes expires on and with January 31st, 1922, and

WHEREAS after that date the penalty will accrue and all taxes unpaid will be delinquent including the last half thereof, and

WHEREAS, financial conditions in said county and throughout the State, in common with sister states are not of the best, and

WHEREAS, the Board after careful consideration of the above premises and after conference with a large number of tax-payers in this county, feels that the period for the payment of the first half of said taxes should be extended for at least thirty days from and after January 31st, 1922.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Treasurer of Tulsa County be and he is hereby authorized at the request of this Board to extend payment of said taxes for said period of thirty days.

And BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event and by reason of the extension of the time of payment of said taxes as herein directed, that the said Treasurer of this county is required to reimburse the county and various municipalities in the amount of any penalties that this Board will at the proper time make an application to the Honorable Excise Board of said County for an appropriation in an amount sufficient to reimburse said Treasurer in any sum or sums that he may be required to pay in the county treasury.

The vote on the motion was as follows: F. M. Wooden "AYE" Ira Short "AYE" Geo. E. Gilmore Absent.

The county clerk announced the result of the vote to be, total "AYE" two "NAYS" none, and the chairman declared the resolution carried and ordered the same made of record and a copy duly certified and delivered to the County Treasurer.
