Melvin C. Rice, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

Motion made by Rice, seconded by Harris, to approve and authorize execution by the Chairman, on behalf of the Assessor, the following items:

1. Letter of intent to Purchase Boeckh Residential Cost Systems from American Appraisal Assoc. Inc.
2. Contract with American Appraisal Assoc., Inc. for residential construction cost manuals and computer software.
