Motion was made by W. L. North, seconded by J. S. Shaver, that the above and fore-going petition asking for permission to construct telephone Line be and the same is hereby granted subject to the rules and regulations laid down by the County Engineer. Motion carried.

The following County Depository Bonds and Continuations have been examined, found sufficient and approved:

First National Bank of Bixby, as Principal and Title Guarantee & trust Company, as Surety, in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars.

Planters and Mechanics Bank as Frincipal and Integrity Mutual Casualty Company, of Chicago, Illinois, as Surety, in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars.

Continuation - First National Bank of Sand Springs, Oklahoma as Principal and Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, Surety.

Continuation - Exchange National Bank Tulsa, Okla. as Principal and National Surety Company of New York as Surety.

In the matter of the application of the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, for the use of the public highways of Tulsa County, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining poles, wires, and other apparatus for the purpose of transmitting and selling to inhabitants and to other Cities and Towns electricity for light, heating and power purposes, after a hearing on the said application, and upon motion of W.L.North, which motion was duly seconded by J.S.Shaver, the following order was made:

Now, on this 21st. day of April, 1924, the application of the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, for the use of certain public highways and section lines within Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining poles, wires and other apparatus and appliances for the purpose of transmitting and selling to inhabitants and to other cities and towns of said County, electricity for light, heat and power, coming on to be heard, the Board finds that said Petitioner, Sand Springs Homes is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and is authorized by its charter to furnish electricity for heat, light, and power to various inhabitants and municipalities within the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma; that said Sand Springs Hone has entered into contracts to furnish various cities, towns and municipalities with electricity, and that in order to furnish said electricity to said towns and municipalities and inhabitants thereof, it will be necessary to lay and maintain, on, cover and across the following public highways and section lines in said County, poles, wires and apparatus and other appliances as may be proper to transmit said electricity to said municipalities, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 31, Township 21, North, Range 13 East; thence East three miles along section line and public highway between Sections 31,32 and 33, Township 21 North, Range 13 East, and Sections 6,5, and 4, Township 20 North; Range 13, East; thence North one mile along the section line between Sections 33 and 34, Township 21, North, Range 13 East; thence East approximately 3½ miles along the section line between Sections 27 and 34, 26 and 35, 25 and 36, and 30 and 31, Township 21 North, Range 13, East, to the Towns of Owasso, Oklahoma, all in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

2.

Beginning at the South limits of the City of Collinsville, thence South along the public highway through Section 32 and between Sections 31 and 32, Township 22 North, Range 14 East; thence South along the public highway and Section line between Sections 5 and 6, 8 and 7, 17 and 18, and 20 and 19, Township21 North, Range 14 East; thence West approximately ½ mile along the section line between Sections 19 and 30; thence South approximately ½ mile through Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 14 East, to the Town of Owasso Oklahoma, all in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, That the Sand Springs Home be and is hereby authorized to use the above described highways and section lines within said County for the purpose of constructing, laying and erecting the necessary poles, wires, apparatus and appliances necessary for the purpose of transmitting and furnishing said electricity.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED. That the installation of said poles, wires, etc., shall be made under the direction of the County Engineer and in such places and manner consistent with necessity to least interfere with other public uses of said highways and section lines and said highways shall not be unnecessarily obstructed and shall within a reasonable time be placed as near as practicable in as good condition and repair as before such construction, at the expense of said Sand Springs Home; that in the event the Board of County Scommissioners decide at any time to widen the highways and section lines used by Said Sand Springs Home, will move its pole
