O R D E R

NOW, On this 25th. day of October, 1926, the petition of the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, asking permission of the Board of County Commissioners to use the public highway hereinafter described for the erection thereon of poles, wires and equipment for the transmission of electricity for light, heat and power purposes, coming on to be heard, and the Board of County Commissioners having duly examined said petition and being fully advised in the premises finds that it is necessary that the Sand Springs Home an Oklahoma Corporation, have the use of said public highways hereinafter described for the erection thereof on poles, wires and other equipment for the transmission of electricity for light, heat and power purposes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma, that the Sand Springs Home, an Oklahoma corporation, with its principal office at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby authorized to, and consent is hereby given for it to have the use of the following described public highway in said County of Tulsa, for the erection thereon of poles, or posts, on which are to be placed wires and other apparatus and equipment for the transmission and sale of electricity to consumers for light, heat and power purposes, to-wit:

The public road and highway running East and West along the
Section line between Sections 19 and 30, and running North
and South along the Section line between Sections 19 and 20,
in Township 22 North, Range 14 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the Sand Springs Home shall pay the sum of \$1.00 per pole for each pole erected on said highway, and that said poles, wires and equipment be placed in such manner as to least interfere with the use of said highway, and subject to the approval of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That said highway shall not be closed or obstructed and that after placing said poles and wires on said highway, the Sand Springs Home, shall at its own expense, place said highway in the same condition of repair, as nearly as possible, as same were prior to the construction thereon of said poles, wires and apparatus.

SAND SPRINGS HOME agreeing at all times to Hold Tulsa County harmless from liability to third persons arising from any actionable negligence on the part of Said Sand Springs Home in the construction, maintenance and operation of said poles, wires and apparatus.
