R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of June, 1945, a bond was ordered forfeited by the Honorable Leslie Webb, Judge of the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in case No. 11874 entitled The State of Oklahoma, plaintiff, vs. Kay Johnston and Cox Hembree, defendants, and Irene Reed and George Elizondo were sureties on said bond in the sum of \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, it appears from an examination of the bond filed and approved herein that only a small amount of money could be realized from a sale of the real estate listed on said bond; and

WHEREAS, the defendants have offered a cash settlement of \$350.00, and it appearing to the Board of County Commissioners that said offer of settlement is fair, reasonable and equitable, and should be accepted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, accept the said offer of settlement, and that upon payment of the sum of \$350.00 cash to the County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that said bond be satisfied in full.
