

MONDAY, JULY 28, 1947

Motion made by Couch and seconded by Evans and unanimously carried that hearing on the petition of Felix J. Mouser and others to form a water improvement district be continued and further heard before this Commission on August 4, 1947, at 10:00 o'clock A.M.

On motion made by Evans, seconded by Couch, and unanimously carried, hearing on the petition of J. O. Grimes and others to organize a water improvement district was passed for hearing to the 4th day of August, 1947, at 10:00 A.M.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the following claims be and are hereby approved for payment, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue warrants covering same.
