MONDAY, JULY 9, 1945

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvenet at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the resignation of William B. Way, Secretary-Treasurer of the Tulsa State Fair as of July 1, 1945, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the resignation of C. A. Mayo, <sup>President</sup> L. D. Shannon, Vice President, Russ R. Stamper and E. Fred Johnson, Members, Tulsa State Fair Board, be and the same are hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the report filed by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the boarding of prisoners for the month of June, 1945, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, County Court Division, for the month of June, 1945, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that Dr. L.D. Presson, Assistant County Physician, be given a salary of \$300.00 per month. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Gray, No; Commissioner Greer, AYE; Commissioner Bailey, AYE. Chairman declared motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray that the rate of interest on County Warrants be fixed at three per cent (3%) per annum. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by William B. Way, Secretary-Treasurer of the Tulsa State Fair Board as of June 30th, 1945, be accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
