DEDICATION OF LANDS FOR HIGHWAY AND STREET PURPOSES.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That for and in consideration of the sum of One and more Dollars to me in hand paid, we do hereby grant, deed and dedicate unto the public, forever, for highway or street purposes; the following described land, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 1320 feet North from the Southwest corner of Section 32, Twp. 20 North, Range 13 East; thence running East a distance of 831.25 feet; thence due North a distance of 25 feet, thence West to the West line of said Section 32, thence South 25 feet to the place of beginning, said lands constituting a part of Independence Street from Lewis Avenue formerly designated as a Section Line.
