Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that an additional \$500.00 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of July, 1938. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

It was brought to the attention of the Board that the Board of Directors of Water Improvement District No. 9 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, had requested the Board of County Commissioners to set the compensation of the officers and directors of Water Improvement District No. 9 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma. Thereupon on motion of Hopkins, seconded by Gray,

"That until July 1st, 1939, the compensation of the three members of the said Board of Directors attending regular meetings of said Board should be \$2.00 per member (no compensation to be received by said Directors for attending special meetings of said Board) and that the Clerk of said Board reveive in addition thereto compensation of \$25.00 per month plus additional compensation of twenty-five cents for each collection of the monthly accounts of the water users,"

Motion was made by Hopkins and seconded by Gray,

"That the petition for the appointment of R. S. McBeth, a resident land-owner in Water Improvement District No. 9 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has been examined, that said pe tition is signed by more than twenty per cent of the resident land owners in said Water Improvement District;

"That said R. S. McBeth is a proper, competent and qualified person to serve as clerk of said Water Improvement District;

That the official bond of said Clerk be set at Three Thousand and No/100 (\$3,000.00) Dollars and that the United Stated Fidelity and Guaranty Company be approved as surety on his bond and J. B. Gray be instructed to endorse his approval on said bond when same is presented and filed. The vote of said motion was: Gray, Aye; Hopkins, Aye.
