RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County proposes to construct, grade and drain, and otherwise improve for road and highway purposes 51st Street east from the Arkansas River / the new bridge crossing same, in Section 36, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, for the proper construction of said road and high-way and its intersection with Riverside Drive, and its approach and access to the new bridge, it is necessary that the County acquire for right-of-way purposes the following tracts of land:
