

Tulsa, Okla July 20, 1910.

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Okla, met in County Clerk's Office in special session. Present W.L. North & C.H. Cleveland absent Geo. Mc Keehan.

The County Clerk and County Treasurer is authorized to invest \$2000.00 in state Building warrants on a 6% per cent basis upon motion of board.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cleveland seconded by Commissioner North. The County Treasurer is hereby authorized to deliver to A.J. McMahan \$200.000 Courthouse \$25.000 Jail \$175.000 Bridge Bonds. Tulsa County upon payment of \$309.300 and accrued interest from July 15-1910 said bonds to be delivered in installments on payment of proportionate amount said accrued interest on bonds from date until July 15-1910 to be allowed to said McMahan in consideration of his payment of Attorney fees, Court costs and all expenses in connection with suit in District & Supreme court of state which was brought to determine validity of bond and in further consideration of his furnishing at his expense lithographed bonds.

Upon motion of board County Clerk was instructed to advertise for sealed proposals for site for Courthouse such proposal to consist of block, half block or quarter block.

To insure good faith a warranty Deed describing property with abstract showing good title must accompany each proposal otherwise same will not be considered.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.

Bids must be filed with County Clerk on or before Aug. 4, 1910 and same to be opened at 10 A.M.  
Aug. 5, 1910.

Upon motion of Board the County Treasurer was instructed to distribute proceeds from sale of bonds among the different depositories according to amount of bond given.

Commission adjourned.
