Now, on this the 15th day of April, 1929, the matter of the Petition of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for permission to lay an underground conduit line along certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Southwestern Bell Telephone Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said company, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit;

Beginning at the Southeast corner of 4th Place and Yale Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma, north along the East side of paved road on Yale Avenue, to the north side of Admiral Place, constructing 5 concrete man holes and placing 6 multiple Tile Duct. approximately 2155'. Main line of trench to be approximately 6' East of East edge of pavement per the attached blue prints. Section 3, township 19 North, Range 14 East.
